

Friday Fast Facts New Property Condition Disclosure Act Statement March 8, 2024

Effective on March 20, 2024, the revised New York Real Property Law Chapter 50, Article 14 (known as the "Property Condition Disclosure Act") will mandate that all sellers of residential properties must complete and provide a Property Condition Disclosure Statement to the buyer before finalizing a sales contract.

Previously, sellers had the option to offer buyers a \$500 credit at closing to waive the disclosure requirement. This new law removes the "credit provision" and now necessitates sellers to reveal the flood history of the property being sold in the updated PCDS form.

The exemptions from the original law remain unchanged, meaning sellers who were previously exempt will remain exempt under the revised legislation.
